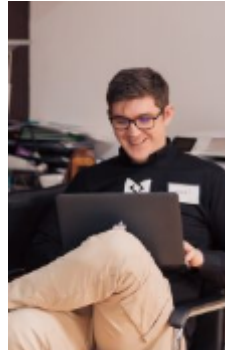

■ REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION

Photo ID and evidence of citizenship (international students must provide copy of passport)

■ FURTHER INFORMATION

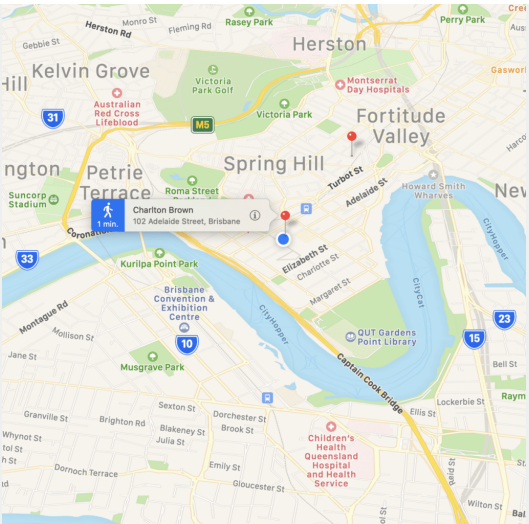

Criteria may change at any time without notice. Additional English language requirements may apply to international applicants from non-English speaking backgrounds wishing to articulate on a visa package into a university programme. Students must be able to (and are required to) enrol, participate, demonstrate progression-of, and complete this course.
