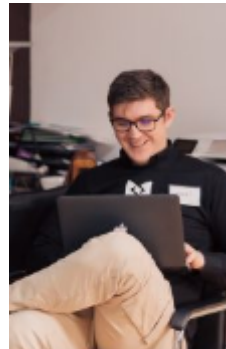

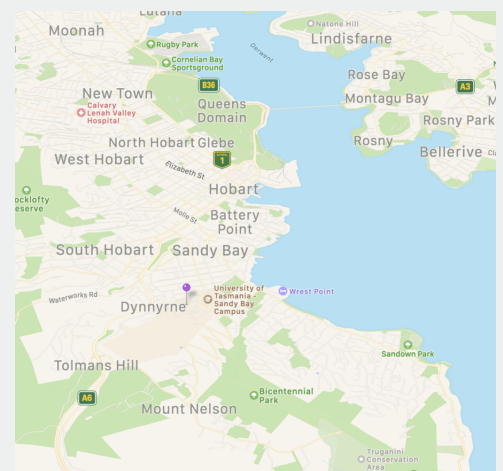
Jan Cisler
